Mission:

USEUCOM executes a full range of multi-domain operations in coordination with allies and partners to support NATO, deter Russia, assist in the defense of Israel, enable global operations, and counter trans-national threats in order to defend the U.S. homeland forward and fortify Euro-Atlantic security. Should deterrence fail, USEUCOM is prepared to fight alongside allies and partners to prevail in any conflict.



By the Numbers:

The command is composed of approximately 79,000 military and civilian personnel and is responsible for U.S. defense operations in Europe.
